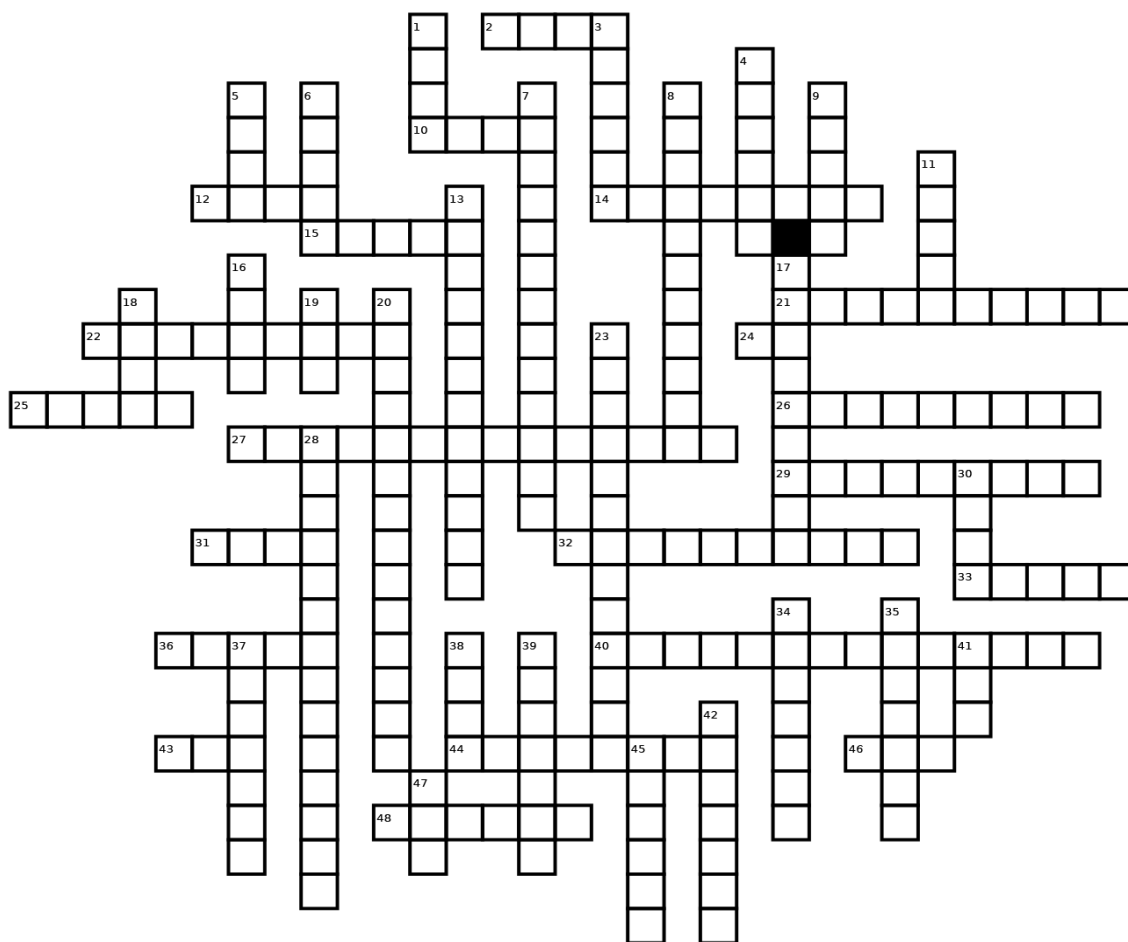
Russ noticed how happy people seemed to get when they discovered an extra fry at the bottom of their sack. So he started dropping a few in, just to be nice.
